# **Dr. Richard Bennett**



Doctor Richard Bennett was born in Sudbury, Ontario, Canada. He received a BA/MA at BYU and PhD at Wayne State University. He was the Director of Archives and Special Collections at the University of Manitoba, Canada for 20 years before being invited to join the faculty of Church History and Doctrine at BYU where he worked for 24 years becoming the Department Chair and Associate Dean of Religious Education. Bennet has published nine books and over 70 articles in Church History, including "Mormons at the Missouri" (University of Oklahoma Press), "Temples Rising" (Deseret Book), and "We'll



Find the Place". He has also edited and published with Deseret Book "The Journey West," the 1846-47 overland Mormon trail journals of Horace K. Whitney. He is presently co-authoring a study on the coming forth of the Book of Abraham.

Dr. Richard Bennett is married to Patricia Dyer. They have five children, twenty-nine grandchildren, and eight great grandchildren. Bennett and his wife, Patricia served as directors for the

Nebraska and Iowa Historic

Sites from January, 2021 to February, 2023.

Dr. Bennett will share "Celebrating Anew the Iowa Call of the




Mormon Battalion and the new Kanesville Visitors Center Site". Bennett will be joined by President Dennis Fors of the Iowa Nebraska Historic Site.


